The vision that energizes our work is seeing the Church of Dane County united in transformational love - a love that is seen and felt - to the glory of God and flourishing of all. This kind of unity is an opportunity for the Church to be a light and a source of great hope in our world today. These past twelve months, we have been blessed to work with nearly 100 Dane County churches by bringing pastors, church leaders, and members together around the table; classes; 24-7 prayer; service projects; a coworking space; and much more. We are seeing the Church of Dane County tell a better story! 
